
1 Introduction

This document serves as an overview of the code structure of *xsupplicant*. It's intended purpose is to agree on a model to code to such that future bug fixes, features, and other updates can be discussed in a more structured manner. This document, like *xsupplicant*, is a work in progress.

2 Current Code Flow

The diagram below attempts to capture the current flow of information through the *xsupplicant* code. Note that this assumes normal operation. Error conditions are outside the scope of this section, unless explicitly stated. The following notation is used below:

- **File names** are in **red**.
- **Function names** are in **black**.
- **Pseudocode** is in **blue**.
- **Data** is in **green**.
