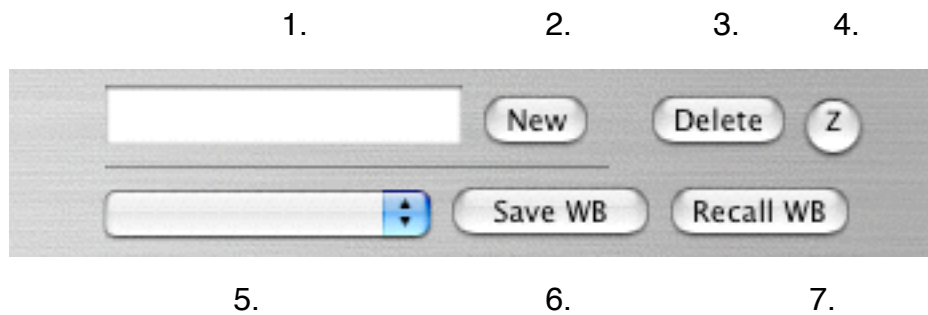


## Saving and Loading Projects

Screenshot of the lower right corner of the Work bench:



- Key:**
1. Form field for new project name
  2. After entering the name into (1) press this button to register a new project
  3. Delete the project showing in (5)
  4. Zap (delete) all the projects; good for starting all over again
  5. List of saved projects
  6. Save the current work bench (the list of open files, the init file, and the code file) to the project showing in (5) replacing what was there
  7. Reload the project showing in (5).

Comments and guides:

A. You can only use button 7 after you close all document windows. The Files list on the work bench must be empty.

B. The search list and search flags are not saved with the project

C. Use button 6. to register changes (additional documents, different code files, other changes in the workbench) in the current project. Do not use button 6, to save changes to individual documents Use button 2 to create a project for the first time.

D. Saving a project does not save any of the documents. It simply saves a list of what documents are open and which documents are the code and init files.

E. Delete and zap do not affect documents; nothing is deleted but a list that contains the name of documents. The documents themselves are not closed if they are open and not damaged or deleted.

F. Projects are stored in the same file as the options selected in the preference panel. This is a file that the computer creates, not you. There is no separate file created for projects.
